Introduction

This document details the installation approach for Language Packs for OpenText™ Content Server by Cassia.

Verify the Technical Requirements

Language Packs for OpenText™ Content Server by Cassia are packaged for specific versions of OpenText Content server and have the following naming convention (aligned generally with OpenText naming):

```
langpack_<CSVER>_cs64_<PLATFORM>_<LANGCODE>-CassiaCM[-NoHelp]
```

Where:

- **CSVER:** The version of Content Server supported.
- **PLATFORM:** Whether it's for Windows or Linux-based systems.
- **LANGCODE:** The language code of the pack.
- **[-NoHelp]:** Packs with this suffix contain just the in-product menu labels, etc. No additional online help files.

Installation Process

Installation of Language Packs for OpenText™ Content Server by Cassia follow the traditional manual approach given by OpenText.




This installation process must be followed on each Content Server instance separately. Ensure that when installing in a cluster that you can access each instance individually.

To install the language packs:

1. Unpack the compressed “langpack” file into the <OTHOME>. The unpacking can be confirmed by navigating into the <OTHOME>/langpkgstaging folder and subfolders to see the new files. E.g. <OTHOME>/langpkgstaging/languagepackage_16_2_0/lang_<LANGCODE>

2. Within Content Server, navigate to the Admin Index → Core System - Language Configuration → Install Language Packs:



Core System - Language Configuration

Date Formats
Specify date formatting and time zone handling for entry and display.


Language
Manage the UI languages supported by Content Server, including enabling, disabling, and setting the system wide default UI language.

View Languages
View a list of all installed Content Server and module language packs.

Install Language Packs
Install any new language packs that are available for installation.

User Name Display
Specify name formatting for display.

3. Select the language as appropriate and click "Install":








